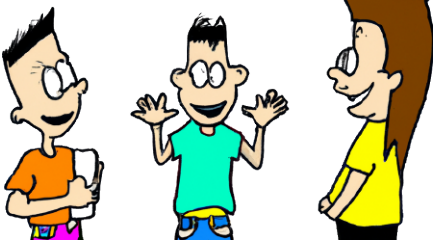




Exercises for practising Present Simple, Present Continuous and Past Tense.
