

## **Reflexive Pronouns (1)**



Do you know how to use reflexive pronouns?

These are the reflexive pronouns:

• We use reflexive pronouns to emphasise that someone did something on their own, but they are also needed when using certain verbs (for example: teach, help, introduce, hurt etc.)

I - myself
you - yourself
he -himself
she - herself
it - itself
we -ourselves
you - yourselves
they- themselves
For example:
Did you hurt yourself?
I cooked the meal all by myself.
The door closes itself.
Hello everyone, please introduce yourselves!
