1 We use reflexive pronouns to emphasise that someone did something on their own, but they are also needed
when using certain verbs (for example: teach, help, introduce, hurt etc.) These are the reflexive pronouns:
you - yourself
he -himself
she - herself
it - itself
we -ourselves
you - yourselves
they- themselves
For example:
Did you hurt yourself?
I cooked the meal all by myself.
The door closes itself.
Hello everyone, please introduce yourselves!
You don't need to take me. I will go home by
