



Do you know how to use reflexive pronouns?

i We use reflexive pronouns to emphasise that someone did something on their own, but they are also needed when using certain verbs (for example: teach, help, introduce, hurt etc.)

These are the reflexive pronouns:

I - myself

you - yourself

he -himself

she - herself

it - itself

we -ourselves

you - yourselves

they- themselves

i For example:

Did you hurt yourself?

I cooked the meal all by myself.

The door closes itself.
