

## **Present Perfect with For and Since (1)**



Practise the present perfect with for and since with us!

We use "since" to talk about a specific point in time, or a time when the action started. For example: We have lived in London since 2015.
We haven't seen each other six years!  since for
I have known him last summer.  of for since
I have lived here 2009. ○ since ○ for
I have not played any games I lost my mobile.  o since o for
how long have you studied Japanese?  Since For
I have played with the new football team two weeks.  for since
She hasn't seen her keys yesterday!  since for

① When using the present perfect we often talk about a specific time or a duration of time in the past. We use "for" to talk about a period of time. For example: We have lived in London for ten years.
