

## **Present Perfect with For and Since (2)**



Practise the present perfect with for and since with us!

We use "since" to talk about a specific point in time, or a time when the action started. For example: We have lived in London since 2015.
I haven't played basketball my injury.  ofor since
My parents have run a bakery four years.  ofor since
I haven't seen him my birthday.  of for since
I have broken my arm I can't do any sports.  Since For
She has practised her performance two years.  for since
Mum has been on the work trip two days.  ofor since
I haven't seen her yesterday.  of for of since

① When using the present perfect we often talk about a specific time or a duration of time in the past. We use "for" to talk about a period of time. For example: We have lived in London for ten years.
